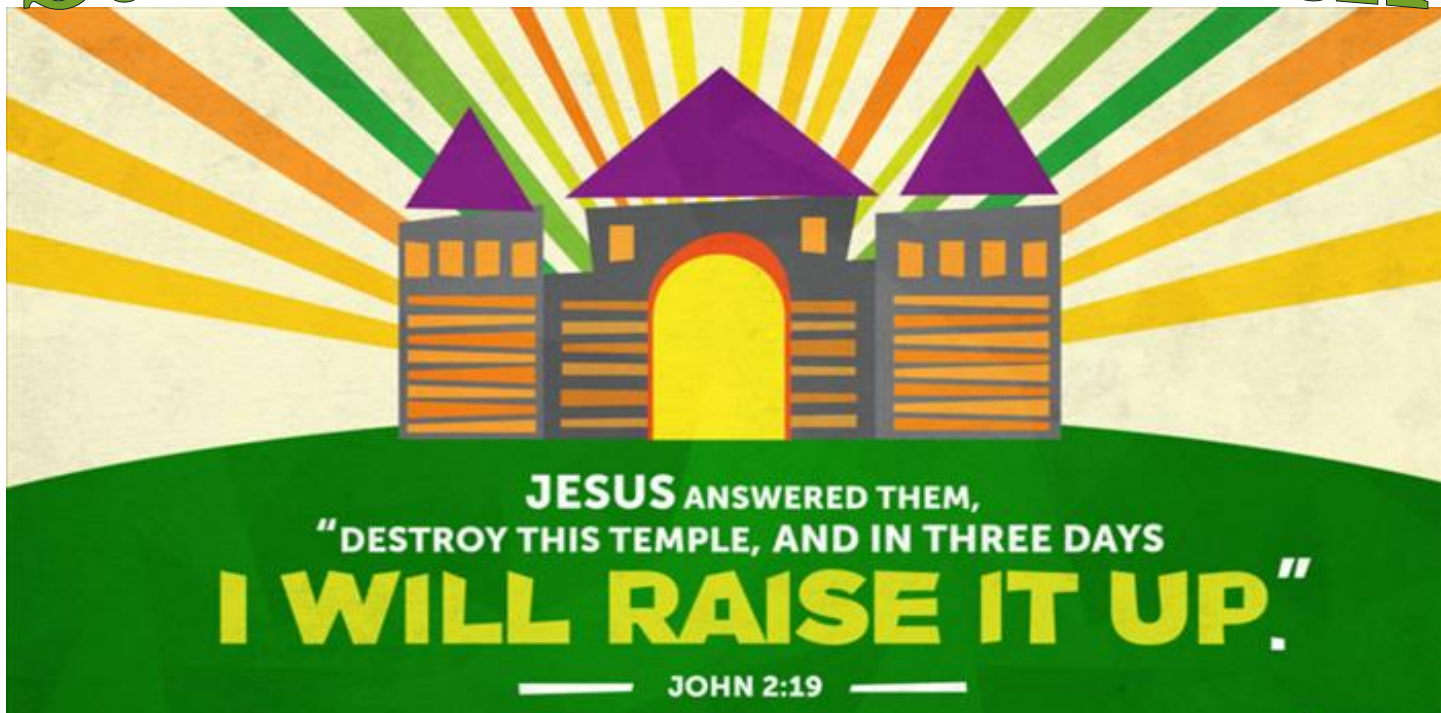

G.P.'s Music Corner

November 9, 2025

Today we celebrate the dedication of the Basilica of St. John Lateran in Rome. This church is the cathedral of the Pope and is called the mother church of all churches. The feast reminds us that every church building is more than a place to gather. It is a visible sign of the Church that God is building in us.

The Scriptures for this day remind us that the true temple of God is not only made of stone. Saint Paul says that we are God's temple because the Holy Spirit lives in us. The Gospel reminds us that our worship should be sincere and directed toward God. The physical church building helps us remember that God is present among His people and that we are called to be united in faith.

This is where the act of singing becomes important. When we sing at Mass, we are doing something together that cannot be done alone. Even if our voices are different, we breathe together, listen to one another, and form one sound. This simple act reflects the deeper truth of the feast. Just as the Lateran Basilica stands for the unity of the whole Church, our singing stands for the unity of our parish community. It is a sign that we belong to one another in Christ.

Singing is not only decoration or background. It is a way of showing with our bodies and our voices that we are one people. When we join in song, we take our place as living stones in the temple God is building. Today's feast invites us to see our singing not as performance, but as participation in the very life of the Church. It expresses who we are. It makes visible the unity that this feast celebrates.
